Do you eat eggs in your daily life? Eggs are rich in nutrients* and have a variety of recipes that you can enjoy; (①), the recipes include boiled eggs, fried eggs like sunny-side up, scrambled eggs, raw egg rice, and more.

Have you ever cooked two sunny-side up eggs from one egg? I've done it (②/) the summer vacation, so today, I'll show you how to cook them from a single egg.

- I Once the egg is frozen, cut it in half. Make sure each half of the egg has some yolk* and some egg white.
- Fry both halves as you usually do for a few minutes, and you'll be able to cook two sunny-side up eggs successfully.
- Put both halves in a frying pan with the eggshells and heat the pan.

 Then, you can remove the eggshells and flatten the surface of the eggs.
- IV If you know the secret, it's easy to cook two sunny-side up eggs. The secret is to put an egg in the freezer before you crack it.

I hope you enjoyed my speech. It's a piece of (③) to make two sunny-side up eggs from one egg, isn't it? Even the simplest ingredients


